What data do we collect?

Fine Print collects the following data:

- Personal Identifiable Information (Name, Email Address, Phone Number)
This data is only collected if it is submitted by site visitor through contact forms.
- Pages viewed
- Time spent viewing website
- Browser used
- Operating system used

How do we collect your data?

You directly provide Fine Print with most of the data we collect. We collect and process data when you:

- Complete the Contact Us form on the website
- Request a demo from the website
- Send an email to our contact email address on our website

How will we use your data?

Fine Print collects your data so that we can:

- Respond to any queries about our products.
- Provide demos for products that you are interested in.

We will not share your data with any third parties.

We will not contact you unless you have specifically requested to be contacted.

How we store your data?

Fine Print stores your data in a restricted mailbox which has limited access with security controls in place. Fine Print will keep your data for 30 days after which time your information will be automatically deleted.

In our website contact form, if you requested to be contacted about additional services, we will keep your email address and name stored in a restricted location until such time you request to be removed.

Marketing

Fine Print will only contact you if you agreed to be contacted about additional services through our website contact form or if you sent an email directly to info@fineprint.ie email link on our website. You have the option to be removed from Marketing at any time by emailing info@fineprint.ie or by responding to a Marketing email requesting to be removed from future email communications.

What are your data protection rights?

Fine Print would like to ensure that you are fully aware of all your data protection rights. Every user is entitled to the following:

The right to access - You have the right to send a request to Fine Print for copies of your personal data.

The right to rectification - You have the right to request that Fine Print correct any information you believe is inaccurate. You also have the right to request Fine Print to complete information you believe is incomplete.

The right to erasure - You have the right to request that Fine Print erase your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to restrict processing - You have the right to request that Fine Print restrict the processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to object to processing - You have the right to object to Fine Print's processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to data portability - You have the right to request that Fine Print transfer the data that we have collected to another organization, or directly to you, under certain conditions.

- **Functional**
Functional cookies help to perform certain functionalities like sharing the content of the website on social media platforms, collect feedbacks, and other third-party features.
- **Performance**
Performance cookies are used to understand and analyse the key performance indexes of the website which helps in delivering a better user experience for the visitors.
- **Analytics**
Analytical cookies are used to understand how visitors interact with the website. These cookies help provide information on metrics, the number of visitors, bounce rate and traffic sources.
- **Advertisement**
Analytical cookies are used to understand how visitors interact with the website. These cookies help provide information on metrics, the number of visitors, bounce rate and traffic sources.
- **Others**
Other uncategorized cookies are those that are being analysed and have not been classified into a category yet.
